Who eats instant noodles? What makes consumers love and 34 them? According to the survey conducted from August 35 October of 2002, 86% of the people 36 in the survey had eaten instant noodles within the past week. The largest 37 among them were male, blue-collar workers and students under 24. The survey also revealed that many students who live in rented housing away from their parents' homes eat a bowl of instant noodles almost every day.

Our sense of smell and the power and pleasure of scent are being **explored** by scientists throughout the world. With the help of technology, researchers examine the brain's response to smell stimulation. **They** have found that brain activity increases in specific parts of the brain when certain smells are picked up by the nose. That is, sensory information from the nose is processed by certain portions of the brain. Many scientific studies have also found that most scents did have an effect on sleep and efficiency. There are a few simple rules that help to prevent us from catching a flu in addition to just getting a flu shot. First of all, **kicking off** the bad habits of letting exercise routine slide or spending too much time indoors in cold weather.
